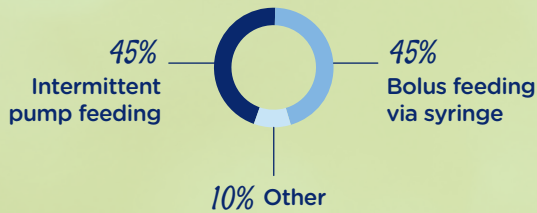

HOW IT WORKS



Insert the **connector** into the end of the **gastrostomy tube**



Squeeze firmly in the middle of the bottle with both hands



Squeezing until it is **completely flat** and all the formula has been given

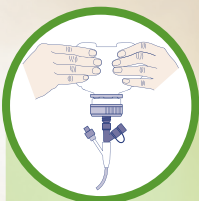

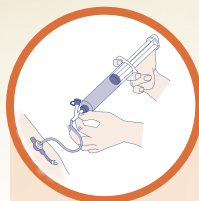

SimpLink® compared to bolus feeding with a syringe



SimpLink®

- Requires **less** time per feeding session (23.3 minutes)
- Requires **fewer** syringes to meet patient's need (5.3 per patient/week)



**BOLUS FEEDING
WITH A SYRINGE**

- Requires **more** time per feeding session (29.5 minutes)
- Requires **more** syringes to meet patient's need (7.4 per patient/week)

More than half of respondents preferred SimpLink instead of bolus feeding with a syringe

Summary

The SimpLink system was highly rated for convenience, safety, hygiene, avoiding spill and mess, and minimal equipment needs, with the majority of respondents (96%) agreeing it was easier to use than traditional bolus feeding approaches and 91% reporting good tolerability of the feeding system.
